The online class and event registration site is used to:

- Register or renew your OLLI membership
- Register for available classes, luncheons, travel, and social events
- Register for a Parking Pass for River's Crossing
- Pay your account balance

<u>How to Register Video</u>

Signing in:

- Go to the <u>olli.uga.edu</u> website.
- Click the **"Members Area"** button in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.
- Select the button that says **"Registration"** for Membership, Classes, Luncheons, Travel, Social Events. You will be taken to the registration Sign-in page.
- As a current member, nter the name and password you used to create your account under <u>Sign In to Existing Account</u>. Then click **"Sign In."**

Viewing and registering for classes, trips, and social events:

- Select the type of activity (Classes, Social Events, Travel) you wish to view.
- Browse through the selections by clicking on a category or alphabetical grouping.
- NOTE: Until registration opens for a particular activity or event, you may only preview it.
- Once you find the activity for which you wish to register, click the **"Add to Cart"** button. The activity will appear in your shopping cart. Click the **"Back"** button to continue shopping for other activities.

Checking out:

• When you have registered for as many activities and events as you wish, click the shopping cart, then follow instructions for payment and processing. You will receive a confirmation email upon completion of your order.
